

RU students rally over 22-point demand

RESIDENTIAL students of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman Hall of Rajshahi University on Saturday staged a demonstration in front of the hall provost's room for two hours, pressing for their 12-point demand.

Their demands include steps to provide safe drinking water and hygienic food, providing WIFI facilities, keeping toilets and bathrooms clean, reduction of

testimonial issuing fee, steps to open the hall library regularly, renovating the internet room and mosque's public announce system, and employing a residential teacher for looking after the students of the hall.

Over a hundred students gathered in front of the hall provost's room around 10:00am and started the demonstration, chanting slogans in favour of their demands.

The agitating students

alleged that they had long been facing the problems because of the authorities' indifference to them.

They alleged that they did not have any WIFI facilities in their hall while the other halls had installed their own WIFI facilities.

The agitating students withdrew their demonstration after the hall provost, Professor Mohamunad Asraf Uzzaman, assured them to meet their demands within seven days.
