Exam fraudsters may have killed him: family

RAJSHAHI University student Motaleb Hossain Lipu may have been killed by members of an admission and recruitment-test fraudster gang, family and fellows have claimed.

Fearing that Lipu could expose the identities of the frauds and for a conflict over payment in a recent contract in connection with a recruitment test of railway, the gang members might have killed him, they said.

Lipu's uncle Bashir Molla said that recently Lipu was sent to jail for posing as candidates in a recruiting test and the members of a fraud syndicate would often threaten him over phone.

According to the post-mortem report, the victim had been hit in the head and then thrown from a high place.

The police, however, said they were yet to find any clues to the murder and they would investigate the matter of the gang. Motaleb Hossain Lipu, a second year student of mass communication and journalism department of Rajshahi University, was found dead in a drain beside the dining hall of Nawab Abdul Latif Hall of the university on Thursday morning.

Lipu's uncle Bashir Mollah filed a murder case with Motihar Police Station on Thursday, accusing unidentified people.

Police arrested two guards of the hall and one of the friends of the victim as prime suspects, but they released the guards after primary interrogation.
