KU PROFESSOR KILLING

Protests enter into 12t day at RU

Teachers-students express their insecurity

TEACHERS, students and members of various organisations of Rajshahi University on Wednesday continued their demonstration on the campus for the straight twelfth day demanding justice to the gruesome murder of Rajshahi University English department professor, AFM Rezaul Karim Siddiquee.

On the 12th day, a number of protest processions, rallies and human chains were

held separately on the campus by the faculty members and the fellow students.

Teachers and students brought out a mourning procession on the cam-pus in front of Shahidullah Arts building around 10:00am and paraded the campus. Later, they held a brief rally at Mukul Mancha, a makeshift platform that was erected after the nickname of the slain pro-

Andolan formed a human chain in front of the university senate building demanding immediate arrest of RU English department. and exemplary punishment of the killers.

Addressing the human chain, Professor Ananda Kumar Saha, former president of Rajshahi University Teachers' Association, said that though four RU Professors had been killed in last 12 years, none got justice.

Later, RUTA also formed a human chain in front of

the university senate building at 11:00am.

Alongside, Islamic history and culture, psychology, applied chemistry and chemical engineering de-partments also brought out independent processions.

Earlier on April 23, a passionate lover of art and music, an amateur photographer and organiser of a music school, editor of a little magazine, Komalgandhar, AFM Rezaul Karim Siddiquee, 58, was hacked to death near his house.
