

Admission tests in Chittagong govt schools begin

THE government school admission tests in Chittagong city for classes five to nine commenced on Wednesday.

Students under cluster 'Ka' participated in the tests to get admitted at Collegiate School, Dr Khastagir Government Girls' High School, Chittagong Government City Girls' High School and Bakalia Government Boys' High School.

Admission seeking students of classes five, seven

and eight sat for the tests from 10:00am to 12:00pm, while class six admission seekers from 2:00pm to 4:00pm in eight examination centres.

Additional deputy commissioner (education) of Chittagong, Habibur Rahman, told New Age that the admission tests were conducted peacefully.

A total of 11,882 students participated in the examinations on the first day, he added.

Students seeking admission under clusters 'Kha' and 'Ga' are scheduled to sit

for the tests on December 23 and 26. Cluster 'Kha' comprises of 20,776 students, while 11,305 students are enlisted under cluster 'Ga'.

Admission providing schools under cluster 'Kha' are Nasirabad Government High School, Government Hazi Mohammad Mohsin High School, Chittagong Government Girls' High School and Bakalia Girls' Government High School. Cluster 'Ga' schools are Government Muslim High School and Chittagong Government High School.
