

Police yet to trace missing SAU student

POLICE were yet to trace the whereabouts of a female student of Sylhet Agricultural University till Tuesday after she had gone missing eight days ago from Sylhet city.

The victim's father, Sanatan Hamum, a man belonging to Manipuri community under Kamalganj upazila in Moulvibazar, said that his daughter Aishee Hamum, 24, a fourth year fisheries student of the university and a resident of the women's hostel on the campus, has gone missing since November 7.

In a general diary filed with Shah Paran police on Friday, Sanatan alleged that Aishee went out of her hostel for the city on November 7 and did not return the hostel since then.

Shah Paran police officer-in-charge Shahjalal Munsif on Tuesday said they became confirmed that Aishee had been kidnapped.

He said they detained a youth, Brajen Singha, from the city early Tuesday for his suspected involvement in kidnapping the victim.

Important information about Aishee was extracted from Brajen and efforts were on to rescue her, the OC added.
