## Clarification on contribution to teachers' salary

Attention of the Government has been drawn to several reports published recently in some dailies on discrepencies occuring in the order of payment issued by the Office of the Director-General Secondary and Higher Education for Government contribution towards the salary of Non-Government School teachers for the 4th quarter of the current fiscal according year. handout.

In the circumstances Government deem it necessary to present the correct picture in this respect:

(1) Government introduced the system of paying government contribution towards the salary of teachers of non-gov-verment institutes through local banks from the beginning of the fiscal year 1982—83 Government has decided that payment of teachers salary for 4th instalment will be made accor-

ding to the bill—prepared for 3rd instalment and changes if any made in favour of the institution fresh bill for new institutions included in the scheme and institutions excluded carlier on the report of the Director of Inspection and Audit out the position corrected by the institutions concerned, later.

have been issued to the banks concerned not to reject any bill which may contain any disparity with the payment order for the 4th instalment issued a few days earlier by the office of the Director-General Secondary and Higher Education.

(3) All Non-Government institutions are requested to contact their respective branch of the bank for payment of government contribution towards teachers salary dearness allowances and recurring grant. It may also be mentioned here that government have placed fund with the banks amounting to Taka about one crore for payment of arrears fallen during the last financial year.

All banks have been advised to complete payment positively by July 10, 1983 at the latest and report compliance to the Government.
