

17 BCL activists sued over Sylhet college clash

SEVENTEEN activists of Bangladesh Chhatra League, including a general secretary of Sylhet district BCL, have been sued by one of their fellow activists in connection with a clash that broke out at Sylhet Murari Chand College.

Rubel, a BCL leader, filed the case with the Shah Paran police station on

Monday night, said Nizam Uddin Chowdhury, officer-in-charge of the station.

Earlier at least 10 persons were injured, including one who sustained bullet injuries, in the clash between two groups of BCL over establishing supremacy over the college campus.

Police also arrested two BCL activists Taj Uddin and Safayet Hossain Pulok on Monday night in connection with the same incident.
