

## Dinajpur Polytechnic closed sine die

DINAJPUR, Sept. 29.—The Dinajpur Polytechnic Institute was closed sine die and the students were asked to vacate their hostels by 3 p.m. on Tuesday following deteriorating law and order on the campus, reports UNB.

All the ongoing examinations have also been postponed until further notice.

The Principal of the Institute said that the situation aggravated after the authorities on Sunday expelled an examinee for two years for insulting and misbehaving with a teacher.

Following the incident, all his fellow examinees have been boycotting the mid-term examination demand-

ing withdrawal of the expulsion order.

The Principal alleged that a group of unruly students had been creating indiscipline on the campus.

Meanwhile, the agitating students brought out a procession in the town on Tuesday and handed over a memorandum to the Deputy Commissioner protesting the action of the authorities.
