

UGC team visits IU for probe

A TEAM of University Grants Commission visited the Islamic University in Kushtia on Saturday to investigate into the allegation of corruption and irregularities in all the recruitment boards of the university.

The four-member probe body comprised Professor M Shah Nowaz Ali, finance and accounts director Md Mizanur Rahman, additional director of public management department Ferdous Zaman, and assistant director of Public Management department Robiul Islam.

The body had been asked to submit their investigation reports as early as possible.

The IU authorities said the committee members talked to the teachers, officers and staffs who are member to the different associations of the university after reaching on the campus in the morning.

The body was scheduled to meet the university vice-chancellor Professor Abdul Hakim Sarker, pro vice-chancellor Professor M Shahinoor Rahman, the proctor Professor M Mahbubar Rahman and the student advisor Professor M Anower Hossen today (Sunday).

Earlier, on February 3, the UGC asked the authorities to suspend all the activities of the recruitment boards until issuance of further notice.
