JU left students demand proctor's resignation

LEADERS and activists of left leaning student bodies of Jahangirnagar University on Tuesday night brought out a torch procession on the campus, demanding removal of proctor immediately.

Around one hundred demonstrators took part in the procession which ended on Amar Ekushay premises

following a short rally.

Jahangirnagar Sanskritik Jote president Zubair Tipu said, 'The proctor failed to ensure the security of the students, so he lost his right to holding this post.'

Bangladesh Chhatra Union JU unit president Dipanjan Siddhanta Kajal alleged that the university administration was trying to save the proctor.

Left leaning students' bodies of the university were demonstrating since April 25, after the Ashulia police had beaten up some leaders and activists of Progressive Students Alliance and arrested 12 leaders and activists who blocked the Dhaka-Aricha highway as part of observing a half-day strike demanding trial in Tonu murder case.
