

## ALLEGATION OF TEACHER ASSAULT

# JU suspends 3 BCL men

THE Jahangirnagar University authorities suspended three activists of the Bangladesh Chhatra League, ruling Awami League-backed student organisation, on Wednesday over the allegation of assaulting a teacher on the campus.

The decision was made at a disciplinary board meeting, chaired by the university vice-chancellor Professor Farzana Islam.

The suspended BCL activists are, Abu Sadat Md Sayem, a masters student of government and politics department, Md Jamshed Alam, a second year student of international relation department and Md Zahid Hasan, a second year stu-

dent of Bangla department; they all are activists of Al Beruni Hall unit of the organisation.

The disciplinary board also formed a five-member probe committee, led by Sayed Hafizur Rahman, chairman of JU hall committee and also the provost of Mowlana Bhashani hall, to investigate the incident.

To be mentioned that JU history department Professor Mojahidul Islam filed a complaint with the proctor office against the three on January 23, for assaulting him as he resisted them while they were assaulting a couple on the campus on January 22.

Following the incident, the organisation suspended the three on January 27.
