

BCL activists hack CU student

THE activists of Bangladesh Chhatra League, Chittagong University unit, on Monday hacked a student suspecting him Islami Chhatra Shibir activist at Jarultola on the campus.

The victim was identified as Omar Faruk, a Bangla department student of the university.

Witnesses said that some BCL activists attacked Omar Faruk suddenly, leaving him injured on the spot. Police rescued and sent him to CU medical centre for treatment.

Mansur Alam, senior vice president of CU BCL unit, claimed that the BCL activists beat and handed over Faruk to police as he was a Shibir activist.

Faruk, however, ruled out the Shibir allegation and said that he did not know why the BCL activists attacked him.

CU police outpost in-charge Mosaddeq Hossain said police rescued Omar Faruk and sent him to CU medical centre for treatment.

On Sunday, BCL activists hacked Jakir Hossain, a student of Marine Science and Fisheries Institute of the university.
