

BCL activist sent to jail over FB comment against MP

A BARISAL court on Monday sent a local Bangladesh Chhatra League activist to jail for doctoring a photo of Awami League lawmaker Jebunnessa Afroj and posting it on his facebook wall.

Police arrested Junayed Ahmed Sumon, a BCL activist of Barisal Govt BM College unit, as Shoyeb Ahmed Sejan, a local Juba League activist, filed a case against Sumon under ICT Act with Kotwali police station in this connection on Sunday night.

Police arrested him from a boarding house in Kawnia area early Monday and sent him to jail after producing him before the Barisal metropolitan magistrate court on Monday afternoon, police sources said.

Shah Md Awlad Hosain, Kotwali police station officer-in-charge, said that the accused doctored a photo of the female lawmaker and circulated it on facebook with a caption that read 'female lawmaker now turned into a female model'.

The college principal Imanul Hakim said that he knew the matter and disciplinary action against the accused would be taken. ||
