

NSU pro-VC, two others arrested

POLICE on Saturday arrested North South University pro-vice-chancellor, his nephew and the caretaker of his building on charge of renting out house to extremism suspects without keeping information about the tenants.

Dhaka Metropolitan Police assistant commissioner Yusuf Ali said that North South University teacher Gias Uddin Ahasan, his nephew Alam Chowdhury and caretaker Mahabubur Rahman were arrested at places in the capital on Saturday evening.

At least 29 people, including 17 foreigners, were killed as gunman attacked a Spanish restaurant in Gulshan on July 1.

Three other people, including two cops, were killed when gunman attacked a police checkpoint near Sholakia Eid congregation on July 7.

North South University students were allegedly involved in both attacks.
