

Female univ teacher found dead in bedroom

A FEMALE teacher of East West University in Dhaka was found dead in her bedroom at Aftabnagar Bhuiyanbari under Badda police station in the capital early Wednesday.

The deceased, Rabeya Kulsun, 26, was a lecturer of the university and daughter of Zahir Ahmed of Halishahar in Chittagong. She lived in the apartment on the second floor of a five-storey

building at Bhuiyanbari area with a female colleague.

Badda police station sub-inspector Al-Mamun said that Rabeya phoned one of her friends Tuesday night and asked not to contact her anymore.

Later, Rabeya's friend informed it to her brother Mohammad Shariful Islam, a

student of North South University in Dhaka, over phone and Shariful tried to contact her over phone in vain.

Sharif later went to Rabeya's apartment and saw through window his sister hanging from the ceiling, Al-Mamun said.

He said that Sharif immediately with the help of the building caretaker recovered

the hanging body of Rabeya, breaking open the door at about 2:00am on Wednesday and rushed her to United Hospitals where doctors on duty declared her dead.

Rabeya was alone in the apartment as her colleague went on a leave a few days ago, the police official said.

He said that they recovered the body from the hos-

pital at about 4:30am and sent it to Dhaka Medical College Hospital morgue for post mortem examination.

Forensic department assistant professor at the hospital Shafiuzzaman, who conducted the post mortem examination, said that he found a black mark round her throat. 'She might have committed suicide,' he said.
