

Professor Munir dies

PROFESSOR ANM Munir Ahmed Chowdhury, political science department teacher of the Chittagong University, died of lung cancer at his residence in Dhaka on Monday morning, said a university press release.

He was 61.

He is survived by his wife, a son and two daughters.

Chittagong University Teachers' Association former president Professor Munir also served as the university senate member, syndicate member, chairman of political science department and CUTA general secretary.

CU vice-chancellor Professor Iftexhar Uddin Chowdhury, pro vice-chancellor Professor Shireen Akhter, acting registrar Professor Kamrul Huda, CUTA President Professor AFM Awrongozebe, and general secretary Associate Professor Sukanta Bhattacharya, in different messages, expressed deep shock at his death and extended sympathy to the bereaved family.

Professor Munir's namaj-e-janaja will be held on Chittagong city's Jamiatul Falah Mosque premises at 10:00am on Tuesday and his body will be buried at his native home at village Barokhaine of Anowara in Chittagong.
