

15 students held in B'baria border

BORDER Guard Bangladesh members detained 15 students, including 13 university ones, from bordering Kashinagar area of Bijoyagar upazila in Brahmanbaria district on Thursday for their suspicious movement.

Of the detainees, nine are students of South East University and one each is of American International University, Prime Asia University, Northern University, Uttara University, Shyamoly Polytechnic Institute and Brahmanbaria Govt College.

Sources at the BGB headquarters said members of

BGB battalion-12 challenged the 15 youths for their suspicious movement at Kashiagar, one km south off Singarbil border outpost.

Later, they were detained and handed over to Bijoyagar police station.

Contacted, additional superintendent of police of Brahmanbaria Shahrir Al Mamun said the detained students revealed that they came to Sultanpur of Bijoyagar to attend a wedding ceremony.

They were arrested for suspicious movement, he said, adding that they will be produced before a district court on Friday after showing them arrested under Section 54 of the CrPc.
