Service rules tornon-govt teachers finalised: PM

The Prime Minister, Shah Azizur Rahman, on Sunday assured the Bangladesh Federation of Teachers Association that the service rules for the non-Government teachers had been finalised and would be made public soon, reports BSS

Any reasonable amendments if necessary, would be considered, and incorporated, the Prime Minister told the leaders and office-bearers of the Federation comprising college, school and madrasah teachers when they called on him at his Secretariat chamber.

The teachers placed their grievances in the context of the Government's commitments in the past.

The Government is also considering a reasonable payscale for the teachers which is pending for processing through relevant ministries. Compared to a grant of Tk 10 crore 35 lakh towards salary of teachers the amount of grant in the current year has been raised to Tk. 29 crore Government contribution towards salary of teachers of non-Government institutions: This may further be raised reasonably consistent with Government resource position.
