Five injured in CU BCL factional clash

FIVE activists of the Chittagong University unit of the Bangladesh Chhatra League, ruling Awami League-backed student organisation, were injured in a factional clash on the campus on Tuesday afternoon.

The injured were identified as political science department student Sheikh

information systems de∙ partment student Hiyam, history department student Shahriar, institute of education research student Niaż Uddin, and physics department student Abdul Halim.

Witnesses said that two groups of activists—one led by the organisation's university unit president Mohammaed Alamgir Tipu and other led by its general sec-Ahmed, accounting and retary AHM Fazle Rabbi Su-

jan, were locked in the clash following an altercation over a trifling matter, leaving the five were injured.

CU BCL senior vice president Mansur Alam said that they would take action against the activists who were involved in the clash.

The university assistant proctor Niaz Morshed Ripon said that they would take proper step against the culprits.
