

test."

He, however, said that the vast majority of students teachers and guardians were opposed to such demand and tendency and added that government was determined to respect and protect their interest.

Mr. Mahbub warned that the examination centres where atmosphere had been vitiated through violence and lawlessness would be discontinued and if necessary the number of examination centres would be reduced.

The Minister pointed out that the government was going to bring about reforms by effecting changes in the education system to inspire the students to devote themselves to the studies and check unfairmeans in the examinations.

At the same time, he said, care should be taken to ensure that the questions were not set up from outside the courses and syllabus.
