

Malaysian delegation meets DU VC

A FOUR-MEMBER delegation, led by Professor Mohammad Bin A Razak, president of Cyberjaya University College of Medical Sciences, Malaysia, called on Dhaka University vice-chancellor Professor AAMS Arefin Siddique at the latter's office on DU campus on Wednesday.

Other members of the delegation were—Professor Nasaruddin Abdul Aziz, dean of the faculty of medicine of Asia Metropolitan University, Professor Amaluddin Ahmad, deputy dean of the same university and Mohammad Jahidul Islam, Assistant Professor of Cyberjaya University College, said a DU press release.

During the meeting, they discussed about various bilateral issues including strengthening ongoing joint collaborative academic and research programs on medical science which are being conducted by Dhaka University, the Asia Metropolitan University, Malaysia and the Cyberjaya University College of Medical Sciences, Malaysia.

A Memorandum of Understanding among these academic institutions was signed on December 27, 2016 aiming at fostering research collaboration, the release added.

They also discussed the necessity of exchanging more teachers and students between the universities.

Professor Md Ismail Khan, principal of Dhaka Medical College and dean of the faculty of medicine, was present at the meeting, among others, the release added.
