

## DU students rally against massacre of Rohingyas

SEVERAL hundred students of Dhaka University on Monday staged demonstration on the campus, protesting against the persistent oppression and massacre of Rohingya minorities in Myanmar.

Around three to four hundred students of Dhaka University held a rally at the base of Raju Memorial Monument around 11:00am after forming a human chain with placards and festoons, urging the United Nations and global human rights bodies to mount pressure on the

Myanmar government immediately to stop the massacre and violence against the Rohingya people.

The protesters also demanded cancellation of Nobel Peace Prize conferred on the Myanmar leader, Aung San Suu Kyi, as she failed to play a tangible role in curbing the violence against the Rohingya people of Rakhine state.

The students also vowed to march towards the Myanmar embassy in Dhaka if the government of Myanmar does not stop the state-sponsored mass killing. //
