

## 31st council session of DU Chhatra Union begins

THE 31st council session of Dhaka University unit Bangladesh Chhatra Union began on Wednesday, with the slogan 'University is not a factory to produce orthodox slave'.

Professor Safiuddin Ahmed inaugurated the two-day programme at Aparajeya Bangla of Dhaka University, hoisting the national and the organisation flags.
