

Teachers hold convention against extremism today

TEACHERS from primary to university level will hold an anti-extremism convention in the capital today.

For the first time, more than 700 teachers from 23 associations across the country will join the assembly at the National Museum at Shahbagh around 10:30am.

Federation of Bangladesh University Teachers Association announced the programme at a press conference at Dhaka University teachers club Tuesday morning.

FBUTA president Professor Farid Uddin Ahmed said, "Teachers representa-

tive from across the country will participate in the convention as the teacher like others want terrorism and militancy-free Bangladesh'.

A proclamation will be presented at the convention and it will be handed over to the education ministry, he said.

Professor Farid Uddin Ahmed will chair the function while education minister Nurul Islam Nahid, home minister Asaduzzaman Khan Kamal, cultural affairs minister Asaduzzaman Noor and minister for primary and mass education Mostafizur Rahman will also address the function.
