QUOTA REFORM Protesters continue strike at univs

STUDENTS and jobseekers, demanding a gazette on reform of quota system for government jobs, continued their indefinite strike at public universities on Thursday.

Bangladesh Sadharan Chhatra Adhikar Sangrakhana Parishad on Monday began their strike as the government did not respond to their deadline for the gazette as per an announcement made by prime minister Sheikh Hasina on April 11.

No classes were held at most of the departments of Dhaka University, at some departments of Jahangirnagar University and others during the strike.

Protesters said they would continue their strike.
