Return to classes, Quader asks students

Awami League general secretary Obaidul Quader on Saturday called on the agitating students to return their classrooms from the streets at the government has been all their demands.

While addressing at a press conference after a meeting of the party's central secretaries, Quader, also road transport and bridges minster, said that the government had taken adequate steps to fulfill the nine points demands of the students for ensuring road safety.

The students had started agitation programmes and took position in different main points of the roads in Dhaka City and controlling traffic system for seven days after killing of two students in a bus accident at Kurmitola bus stand on July 30.
