2,85,056 applicants for RU entry test

A total of 2,85,056 applicants primarily applied for the first year honours courses under 2018–2019 academic sessions at Rajshahi University, scheduled to be held on October 22, 23.

RU Information and Communication Centre director Professor Khademul Islam Molla told New Age that during the preliminary online application process, started on September 03 and continued till the zero hour of Wednesday, a total of 2,85,056 applicants across the country registered their names for the admission test against around 4,173 (except quota) seats under five units.

He said that this year the university authorities would allow only 32,000 students to sit at the admission tests under each of the five units only according to their CGPA results. 'We would publish the name of eligible students on September 17,' Professor Khademul Islam Molla added.

The eligible applicants have to pay the registration fees – Tk 1254 for A unit (arts and fine faculties), Tk 726 for B unit (business studies faculty and IBA), Tk 1254 for C unit (science and engineering faculties), Tk 990 for D unit (life and earth science and agriculture faculties), and Tk 1122 for E unit (social science and law faculties, and Education and Research Institute) through Dutch Bangla Mobile Banking to collect their admit card, he also added.

According to the ICT centre office, 56,407 admission seekers applied under A unit against 941 seats, 37,604 students under B unit against 560 seats, 61,234 students under C unit against 942 seats, 60,293 students under D unit against 612 seats, and 69,518 students under E unit against 958 seats.
