

JU admission tests begins Sept 30

Admission tests into bachelor courses at Jahangirnagar University under the academic session 2018-19 will begin on September 30.

The admission tests will end on October 10, said the schedule published on Tuesday.

'The admission tests will be conducted in five or six shifts on each day of examination. Although the examination schedule has been finalised, we are yet to decide on the number of examination shifts,' said member secretary of the central admission test managing committee and deputy registrar Abu Hasan said.

'After the number of shifts are finalised, we will refer the decision to vice-chancellor Professor Farzana Islam for final approval,' he added.

According to the admission test schedule, the A unit tests under mathematical and physical sciences faculty will be held on September 30 and October 1.

The H unit test will take place on October 1, D unit tests on October 2 and 3, I unit test on October 3, B unit test on October 4, C unit tests on October 8 and 9 and E and G unit tests on October 10.

Online application for the admission tests ended on Sunday while the last date for fee payment was September 22.

A total of 3,22,946 admission seekers registered for the tests under six faculties and three institutes this year, making it the highest number of applications submitted for enrollment at Jahangirnagar University.

'Around three lakh admission seekers have completed the online application process,' member of admission managing committee Associate Professor Wahiduzzam said.
