5 held for cheating in DU Ka unit entrance exam

Dhaka University authorities on Friday detained four entrance exam takers and a guardian on charge of cheating in an exam for admissions in science faculty subjects under Ka Unit.

They were held for using electronic devices, which were prohibited in the exams, and for abetting, said university proctor AKM Golam Rabbani.

The identities of the detainees could not be known immediately.

Golam Rabbani said they were investigating the fraud and identities of the people involved would be revealed following the investigation.

He said some coaching centres might be involved with the offence and if the authorities found anybody responsible, they would take stern action against the fraudsters.

The one and half hour-long bachelor's degree entrance exam was held at 84 centres inside and outside the campus. A total of 81,096 candidates are contesting for 1,750 seats in the faculty.
