

## Bindubasini students demand removal of headmaster

Students of Government Bindubasini Girls' High School in Tangail and their guardians demanded removal of the school headmaster, Abdullah Al Mamun, over his alleged negligence of students' complaint of sexual harassment by a teacher of the school.

They held a press conference at Tangail Press Club on Tuesday morning to press home their demand.

Demanding immediate removal of Abdullah Al Mamun, Shamim Chowdhury, a guardian, alleged that Mamun did not pay any heed to the guardians' repeated complaints of harassment against the school's assistant teacher Saidur Rahman Bablu.

Tahia Tabassum, a student of the school, demanded a safety cell for students, hundred per cent female teachers at the school and stopping of coaching business of the teachers. She also demanded removal of assistant teachers Saidur Rahman Bablu, Habibur Rahman, Maksud Rana and headmaster Abdullah Al Mamun Talukdar.

Meanwhile, Tangail district administration formed a three member probe committee, headed by ADC (Education and ICT) Ashraful Momin Khan, to investigate the incident and asked the committee to submit its report within three days.

The others two members of the committee are — Tangail additional police super Ahaduzzaman Miah and district education officer Laila Khanom.

Earlier on Monday, the school students and their guardians confined Saidur Rahman Bablu in a classroom as he made an indecent proposal to a student of Class IX.

Later, he was handed over to the police and the police produced him before a mobile court, led by executive magistrate M Shahriar Rahman, and the court sentenced him to one-year imprisonment.
