

All set to hold JSC from Nov 1: Nahid

Education minister Nurul Islam Nahid on Monday said the Junior School Certificate examinations would begin on November 1 and the government had taken all necessary preparations for holding the examinations.

'The government has taken all-out measures for holding the examinations without leakage of question papers and unfair means,' he said this at a meeting on the law and order situation at his ministry's conference room.

'Each examinee would have to enter the examination hall 30 minutes before the examination starts,' he said, adding secretary of examination centre would be informed through text messages 25 minutes before the examination about the question paper set.

'If anyone tries to spread rumours over question paper leakage, he or she will not be spared,' the minister warned.

'All educational boards, local administrations and law enforcement agencies have completed preparations regarding the upcoming public examination,' the minister said. The law enforcement agencies and education ministry would remain alert during the examination period, he added.

Education secretary M Sohrab Hussian, additional secretaries D Mahamud-ul-Haque, M Javed Ahmed and Nazmul Haque Khan, the police, RAB and officials of intelligence agencies attended the meeting.
