QUESTION LEAK ISSUE SHUNNED

Meanwhile, the proctor declined to comment when he was asked if they have found any proof of question leaks.

On September 20, the university authorities held the "Gha" admission test amid allegations of question leaks. Several newspapers including The Daily Star published stories showing how the English multiple choice question (MCQ) part of the question was leaked via email or social platforms.

The university authorities, however, published the results within the shortest possible time denying the allegation and snubbing protests from different left-leaning student organisations.
