

PROTEST AGAINST QUESTION PAPER LEAKS

Police foil left students demo demanding Nahid's resignation

POLICE on Sunday barred the march of Progressive Students Alliance, a platform of left student fronts, who tried to lay siege to education ministry demanding resignation of the minister who has 'utterly failed' to check continuous question paper leaks.

Leaders and activists of the platform brought out a procession from Modhu's canteen of Dhaka University that paraded through TSC, Doyel Chattar and adjacent roads before facing obstruction in front of the Bangla-

desh Secretariat leading to a scuffle between the protesters and police.

Facing police obstruction, the students held an impromptu rally there where they said that question paper leak has now become a phenomenon as almost all questions of public examinations were available in the internet an hour before the exams.

They further alleged that instead of the culprits being punished, they were getting encouragement from the government. They alleged that the situation has made offenders feel like their wrongdoing could go with-

out punishment.

While demanding punishment of the culpable persons, they threatened tougher movement to force the education minister to quit from his post.

President of central Chhatra Union GM Zilani Shuvo, Chhatra Federation Golam Mostofa, Chhatra Front (Marxists) president Naima Khaled Monika, Chhatra Front president Imran Habib Rummon, Biplobi Chhatra Moitri's president Iqbal Kabir and joint-convenor of Chhatra Oikya Forum Sarkar Al Imran addressed the rally.
