BCL dissolves IU committee

The Islamic University unit of Bangladesh Chhatra League, a student wing of the ruling Awami League, was dissolved on Sunday night.

President of the central unit of Chhatra League Rezwanul Haque Chowdhury Shovon and its general secretary Golam Robbani issued a press release in this regard around 11:30pm.

The BCL central executive committee also formed a three member probe body to conduct an investigation over allegations that the unit had violated organisation's rules and regulations.

The central BCL committee, however, did not mention the specific allegations that had led to the dissolution.

The probe committee was asked to submit its reports within three working days.

The members of the probe body were Al Nahiyon Joy, M Shakil Bhuiyan and Jahangir Manjil Pipash.

The Islamic University unit committee of Chhatra League was formed on April 17, 2017 declaring the names of only the president and general secretary.
