

SSC, EQUIVALENT EXAMS  
**Examinees to enter hall 30 mins before exams**

THE examinees of Secondary School Certificate (SSC) and its equivalent exams must enter their respective examination halls half an hour before the tests begin, said an education ministry statement issued on Wednesday evening.

The statement said that the ministry took the decision at a meeting on upcoming SSC exam, to prevent copying or any other forms of unfair means in the upcoming exams.


Presided over by the secondary and higher edu-

cation division secretary Sohrab Hossain, the meeting decided that candidates of SSC and its equivalent exams should enter their respective exam halls half an hour before the tests begin, otherwise they would not be allowed to sit for the test.

The meeting also decided that none would be allowed to carry any smartphone at the exam centres.

It was also decided at the meeting that a question bank for the exam would be formed.

The next SSC exam would be held in February.
