

Chhatra Dal calls indefinite strike at BUET

Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET) unit of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) gave a call for strike in the university for indefinite period protesting the programme which was held in connection with the August 15 at the BUET auditorium on Thursday.

The JCD leaders termed the programme as political and said some Awami Bakshali teachers of BUET used the university administration to hold the programme in absence of Vice-Chancellor Prof. M. Shahjahan, says a Press release.

They demanded resignation of those teachers who were connected with the programme.

Meanwhile, Dhaka University unit of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) brought out a procession and held a rally on the university campus on Sunday protesting the anti social activities of Bangladesh Chhara League (S.P).

The JCD leaders blamed that the BCL members were collecting tolls from the businessmen at Palashi and Nilkhet markets. They also blamed them for attacking on businessmen.

The Chhatra Dal leaders blamed that Awami League gave directives to the authorities of all the educa-

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tional institutions of the country to hold programmes in connection with the National Mourning Day. They condemned Awami League for giving such directives and said there were no example in the world of doing such activities.

The rally held in front of the DUCSU building of the University was addressed, among others, by Abdul Khaleq, Monwar Hossain Rana, A.B.M. Mosharraf Hossain, Monir Hossain and Nasiruddin Washim.
