The Education Minister said the proposed consultative committee on educa tion would soon be constitut ed to it cilitate the process of removing the discriminations between the Government and non Government educational institutions and teachers.

Dr. Khan - hoped the committee to be composed of representatives from all recognis ed associations of the teachers of all levels and Government officials would be able to sit within next one and a half months time.

The discriminations in the educational institutions the Minister said were accumulat ed during the last decades due mainly to colonial legacy and mentality. He urged all concerned to make concerted efforts to eliminate the disparities to restore a healthy atmos phere in the educational campuses.

Dr Majeed Khan described the teachers as the backbone of the nation and education as the essential pre-condition for national development.

Without rehabilitating education in the educational institutions and establishing teachers in positions of dignity the Minister said the prospects and dreams for national prosperity would remain unrealised
