BIT, Rajshahi closed sine die

RAJSHAHI, May 19: Academic Council of Bangladesh Engineering and Technology Institute, Rajshahi (BIT, Rajshahi) closed the institute sine die and asked the residential students to vacate their hostels by 8 pm to night.

According to the BIT sources one Durul Huda, a resident student of hostel and a worker of Chhatra League was manhandled in view of a scuffle originated during viewing television Tuesday night. Chhatra League called for strike on the campus in protest against the incident on Wednesday. But Chhatradal brought out procession against it. Chase and counter chase between rival student groups took place began and a total of 35 rooms of Shahidul Islam, Abdul Hamid and Tinshed hostels were damaged by the unruly students and some rooms of Selim Hostel and tin shed hostels were set on fire. During clashes Chhatra League drove Chhatradal students outside the campus on noon. Over ten students were injured during the clashes. Police were posted in the campus to avert further incident. Till filing this report students were leaving the hostels.
