## 22nd convocation of NSU held

The 22nd convocation of North South University was held yesterday on its own campus in Bashundhara Residential Area amid enthusiasm and festivity.

On behalf of Chancellor of the university President Abdul Hamid, Education Minister Dr Dipu Moni presided over the ceremony, said a press release.
