Police hurriedly went to the spot and got in to the campus by breaking open the main gate which was kept closed by the students, fired tear gass shells and brought the situation under control. It may be mentioned that only twelve out of 191 examinees come out successful in this year's Final Diploma Examination scheduled to be held in 1988. The agrieved examinees in a body met the Deputy Commissioner and handed over to him a memorandum seeking redress to the injustice done to them.
