Polytech teachers go on strike today

Teachers of country's twenty polytechnic institutes will go on work abstention for indefinite period from today (Monday) demanding immediate realisation of their 10-point charter of demand.

The demands include promotion of teachers and employees, regularisation of services of the teachers who were recruited earlier on adhoc basis, regular payment of stipend money to the students and introduction of post-graduate course in technical colleges.

Bangladesh Polytechnic Shikshak Samity (BPSS) in a statement on Sunday criticised the Government for not realising the demands and said the respective ministry earlier made assurance several times in this respect but no effective steps were taken till now.

Teachers of Dhaka Polytechnic Institute will hold a rally at 10 a.m. today at Institute premises in support of the strike programme.
