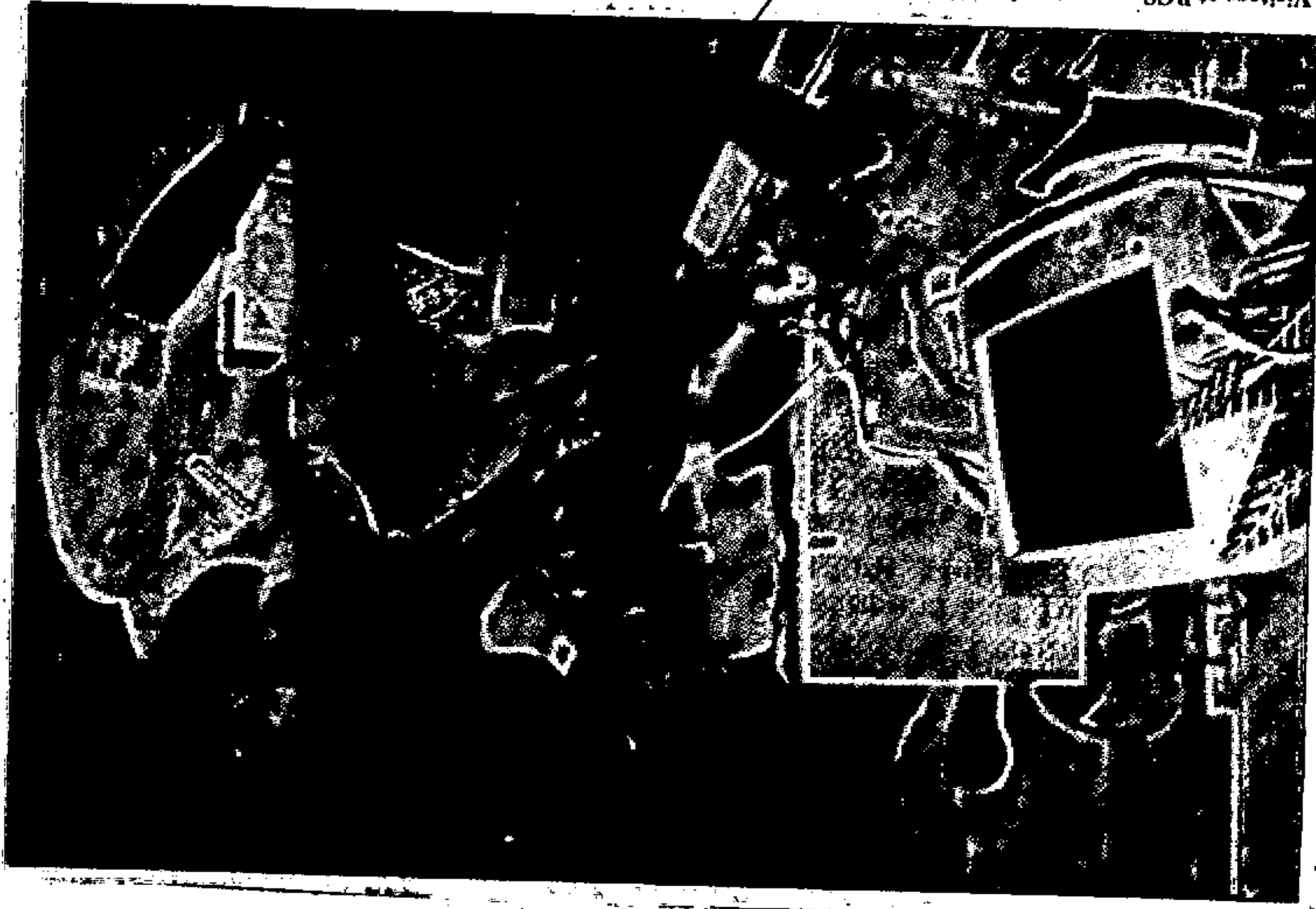




Visitors at BCS computer show '99 which was inaugurated at IDB Bhavan at Agargaon in the city on Saturday.
