BUET cuts marks on class tests

The Academic Council of Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET) at a meeting Wednesday decided to reduce the marks on class test system of the university, BUET sources said, reports BSS.

According to the new rules 10 per cent marks have now been allotted on each subject for each semester instead of 20 per cent. It was unanimously adopted after the five hours debate on the issue by the council.

The BUET students demanded abolition of class test and have been boycotting their classes on the issue since mid-October. The students have already lost two and a half months from their scheduled academic session.
