BUET remained closed for 266 days last year

Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET) remained closed for 266 days out of 365 days last year.

The closed 266 days include 146 days of national holidays, Ramzan and weekly vacation. The university was closed for 12 days due to strike called by different political and students organisation. And during the remaining 108 days classes could not be held as the two-point movement of the students continued from October 16 to January 3.

Meanwhile, the Engineering University Central Students Union (EUCSU) election is going to be held on February 8. The last date for submission of nomination papers is February 1.

It may be mentioned that the All-party BUET Students Committee (APBSC) has warned that they will not participate in the ensuing EUCSU election if the authorities do not withdraw the expulsion order of three students. The three students were expelled for one year due to their alleged involvement in destructive activities during the two-point movement.
