

Mohiul Ulem Orphanage School needs attention

Mohiul Ulem Orphanage at Panchkhain under Raozan Upazilla is beset with multifarious problems due to accommodation crisis, shortage of furniture, inadequate number of Teachers and Teachers and constraints of funds.

The orphanage was established by Moulana Hakim Mubarak Ali Hezazi in 1980 in the village of Raozan but no remarkable development has yet been done. The orphanage has now about 100 students most of whom are under 15 years. There only 5 rooms in the orphanage which is inadequate to accommodate the students and teachers. Moreover insufficient number of benches has created sitting problem.

It is the only orphanage in the Upazilla where orphan students are imparting religious education side by side Vocation Training but the concerned authorities have not taken any positive step to develop it.

The roof of the main building of the orphanage is in a deplorable condition which may collapse at any movement causing damage to both lives and property. During the rainy season waters trickle through the leakage of the roof causing much inconveniences to the students.

Most of the teachers and

employees of the orphanage are suffering due to absence of residential facility. The orphanage has no residential quarter and the teachers are to reside in the rooms of students.

The orphanage authority has taken a programme to open a sewing section but they find it difficult to execute the programme due to fund shortage. They urged upon the Government to take necessary step to mitigate the problems to create good academic atmosphere in the orphanage.
