



Cheques for private schools handed over to banks

The government cheques against salary and allowances of teachers and employees of private schools for the month of January have been handed over to the head offices of Agrani, Janata, Sonali and Rupali Banks on January 26 for their distribution before the Holy Eid Ul Fitr, a PID handout said today, reports BSS.

The heads of educational institutions have been asked to collect the sums from their respective bank branches. Those educational institutions or teachers and employees who could not withdraw the sums of the first six months of the current financial year for valid reasons, would also be able to draw their money during this time limit.

Meanwhile the time limit for the withdrawal of the government portion of the salary of the teachers of Ibtedaye Madrasa has been extended upto February 15.

It further said that till government nominates at thana level officers are nominated to sign the salary bills of the teachers of Ibtedaye madrasas. TNOs have been empowered to work as drawing and disbursing officer and asked all concerned to take necessary steps in this regard.
