He said the curriculum Board of Medical Education is now examining the matter in detail for inclusion of the subjects in the syllabus.

Emphasising the need for acquiring adequate knowledge about hospital administration as well as man-management relations the Minister said these qualities are essentially required for the growth of effective medical institutions in the country. He said efficiency in hospital administration would not only alleviate the fears and worries in the minds of the people about the existing conditions in the hospital but will also help earn confidence of the patients in general.
