No roll number from Class VI to Class X

The government has ordered the schools not to set roll numbers of the students based on the results but to issue identity numbers after their promotion to new classes this year.

A Directorate of Secondary and Higher Education circular issued on Sunday asked all the government and non-government schools across the country not to give roll numbers as they were promoted to new classes based on an evaluation of their assignments but not answer scripts.

DSHE director general Syed Md Golam Faruk said that the new identification system would continue in future for stopping the undesired competitions among the classmates.

‘We rather want to evaluate the talents of the schoolchildren through continuous assessments as done abroad. We also want them to work in groups,’ he said.

The identity numbers would help execute these plans, he said.
