Pre-selection test for admission to BUET held

Undergraduate pre-selection test for admission to Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology for the 2021-2022 academic sessions was held on the campus on Saturday, said a press release.

A total of 17,034 students got the opportunity to participate in the examination. The test was conducted through 100 multiple-choice questions. The attendance rate was over 95 per cent.

The last date for publication of the list of eligible applicants for the main admission test is June 11. The list will be published on the university's website (www.buet.ac.bd). The main admission test will be held on June 18.

The main entrance test will be held in written form for 2 hours. The exams will include mathematics, physics, and chemistry for groups A and B.

Students will be admitted to 12 departments under the faculties of engineering, civil engineering, mechanical engineering, electrical and electronic engineering, and architecture and planning.

In this year's admission test, the total number of candidates is 17,034, against a total of 1,279 seats.

The last date for publishing the list of selected and waiting candidates for admission is July 6, 2022.
