BCL activists oust student from his room at RU hall

Leaders and activists of the ruling Awami League-backed student organisation Bangladesh Chhatra League allegedly forcefully removed a student from his allocated seat at Dr Shaheed Shamsuzzoha Hall of Rajshahi University Thursday night.

Witnesses said that the hall unit Chhatra League leaders and activists ousted third-year student of physics Shariful Islam from his allotted seat at 10:30pm.

Shariful told New Age that he was allotted the seat in Room 214 of the hall in 2021, but could not manage to get onto the seat until recently.

‘A group of five to six BCL men, including Shohag and Roni, followers of BCL hall unit president Chirantan Chandra, threatened him at 2:00am early Wednesday with dire consequences if I did not leave the room’, he alleged.

Shariful said that the BCL men came again on Wednesday night and kicked my bag and baggage from the room to the veranda.

He said that he had informed the hall provost about the incident.

Shaheed Shamsuzzoha Hall provost Ekramul Islam told New Age that they would relocate the student to his seat.

BCL hall unit president Chirantan Chandra, however, denied the allegation.
